I hope you are well.

I am writing to follow up on the selection of two jurors from Colombia/South America, I wanted to share with you the following:

The Colombian juror will be Adrián Chamorro.

Adrián Chamorro is a Colombian violinist, conductor, and pedagogue with an international career spanning Europe and Latin America. He studied at the Tchaikovsky Conservatory in Moscow and later worked extensively in Paris, collaborating with leading figures in historically informed performance such as Philippe Herreweghe and Jordi Savall. He has performed as a soloist with major orchestras in Colombia and abroad, and has led ensembles including the Orquesta Clásica de Colombia and the Orquesta Barroca de Colombia.

Regarding the juror who could be supported by an embassy, Santiago suggests having a brief brainstorm with you and Juan Carlos to explore possible names that can lead to sponsorship options and define the best approach. Normally the Austrian Embassy will be interested in sponsoring a jury, as well as Spain and France. But if other names/nationalities appear @Natalia Sefair López will let us know if they are viable. This would allow us to move forward efficiently while also considering potential institutional support opportunities.
