- I don't know **who's** coming.

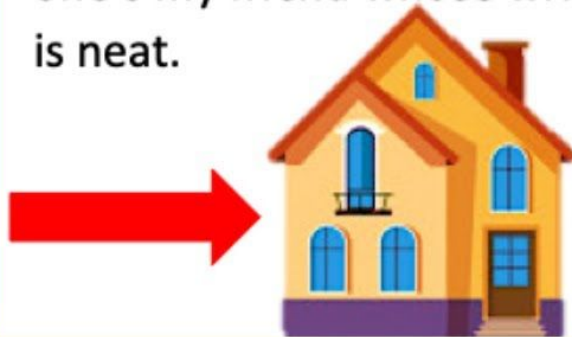


Whose

Possessive form of **who**.

For example:

- Whose book is this?
- She's my friend whose writing is neat.

possessive adjective + noun

Possessive pronoun

possessive pronoun (+ no noun)

my This is *my* chair.

mine This chair is *mine*.

your Is this *your* bag?

yours Is this bag *yours*?

his Those are *his* keys.

his Those keys are *his*.

her That's *her* phone.

hers That phone is *hers*.

its *Its* handle is brown.

its *We avoid using 'its' on its own as a possessive adjective

our This is *our* house.

ours This house is *ours*.

your These are *your* books.

yours These books are *yours*.

their That's *their* car.

theirs That car is *theirs*.
