EVIDENCIA 2: WORKPLACE MAP, DIRECTIONS AND HOMEWORK TASK

Topics from the guide: prepositions of place and movement, imperatives, places in a company, asking for and giving directions.

1. Presentación del tema

In this homework version, apprentices learn how to locate places inside a company, ask for directions, and write clear routes in English. The work is individual and handwritten. First, students study the topic with video support and a short grammar reminder. Then, they complete guided practice based on the original guide. Finally, they create their own workplace map and write a short dialogue and a route paragraph as the final evidence.


Grammar focus:

- Prepositions of place: next to, between, on the corner, in front of, behind.
- Expressions of movement: go straight, turn left, turn right, walk past, cross.
- Imperatives for directions: go, turn, walk, cross, stop.
- Useful questions: Where is the warehouse? How do I get to the quality control area?



3. Práctica libre – descripción de la evidencia

Modalidad: Tarea individual

Descripción:

Elaborar de forma individual un plano sencillo de una planta, empresa o área de trabajo y redactar una interacción escrita para pedir y dar indicaciones sobre ubicaciones específicas dentro del lugar. El aprendiz debe usar referencias espaciales, movimientos e instrucciones claras para guiar a otra persona dentro del entorno laboral. Como se trata de una tarea, el desarrollo será individual, escrito a mano y entregado en PDF por Google Classroom.

Temas:

Prepositions of place and movement, imperatives, places in a company, asking for and giving directions.

Evidencia:

Plano en inglés + diálogo escrito individual + ruta escrita en inglés + entrega en PDF.

Entregable de la evidencia

- One hand-drawn workplace map in English with at least 8 places.
- One written dialogue in English with both roles (minimum 8 interventions in total).
- One short route paragraph of 4 to 6 sentences based on the map.
- One PDF with the handwritten work uploaded to Google Classroom.

Instrucciones

4. Watch the two videos and take notes before starting the homework.
5. Draw your own workplace map by hand. Include at least 8 places such as: main gate, reception, office, warehouse, bathroom, cafeteria, meeting room, production area, emergency exit, laboratory, quality control, or safety office.
6. Add arrows, paths, or simple streets or corridors so the routes are clear.
7. Write one dialogue where one person asks for directions and the other person answers. You must write both roles yourself.
8. Write one short route paragraph explaining how to get from one place to another on your map.
9. Do the complete task by hand and upload it as one PDF file.

Mandatory language requirements

- Use at least 4 expressions of movement.
- Use at least 3 expressions of place.
- Use imperatives correctly.
- Use complete sentences in the dialogue and the paragraph.
- Keep all labels on the map in English.

Clear example of how the evidence can look

Sample dialogue:

A: Excuse me, where is the quality control area?

B: It is between the warehouse and the production area.

A: How do I get there from reception?

B: Go straight to the office, turn right, and walk past the office. The quality control area is on the left.

Sample route paragraph:

Go straight from the main gate to the reception. Then turn right to the office. Walk past the office and continue to the quality control area. It is between the warehouse and the production area.

Note: Bring your finished homework to class because the written dialogue can be used later for oral practice.

4. Criterios de valoración

- Accurate use of directions and prepositions.
- Clear and organized map.
- Correct use of imperatives.
- Coherent written dialogue and route paragraph.
- Handwritten presentation and complete submission.
