- Use the simple present for routines, habits, facts and general situations.
- With I / you / we / they, use the base verb: work, study, live.
- With he / she / it, add -s or -es: works, studies, lives, watches, goes.
- Negative form: do not / don't + base verb; does not / doesn't + base verb.
- Questions: Do + subject + base verb...? / Does + subject + base verb...?

Model:

Affirmative: She works in quality control.

Negative: She doesn't work on Sundays.

Question: Does she work in quality control?
